Members Update

MICPA Practising Certificate

The Membership Affairs Committee of the Institute in considering applications for practising certificate, has frequently come across cases where a member has commenced public practice before he is issued with a practising certificate by the Institute. The Committee would like to remind members that in accordance with **bye-law 65** of the Institute's bye-laws, a member shall be entitled to engage in public practice in Malaysia only if he holds a practising certificate issued by the Institute.

Renewal of Auditors Licence

The Institute would like to remind members who are approved company auditors to submit the applications for renewal of their auditor's licence to Ministry of Finance (MOF) at least 3 months before their licence expires to ensure continuity of their licence's period. section 9(1)(a) of the Companies Act 1965 prescribes that a person shall not knowingly consent to be an auditor if he is not an approved company auditor. The approval and renewal of auditor's licence under section 8 of the Companies Act 1965 is for a period of two years unless sooner revoked by MOF.

According to a recent report in the newspapers, the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) had so far conducted inspection on 269 auditors' files this year. The main objective of the inspection is to ensure that the company auditor is an approved company auditor. Out of the 269 auditors' files inspected, 11 auditors breached section 9(1)(a) of the Companies Act 1965 for expired licence. 11 Notices amounting to RM185,000 were issued. 9 auditors and 44 partners breached section 9(4)(a) of the Act as not all the partners were authorised auditors. 53 notices amounting to RM1,067,000 were issued.

Updates from Regulatory Bodies

Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB)

MASB issues limited amendment to Forex Standard and Accounting Interpretations

The MASB on February 15, 2007 announced the issuance of a limited amendment to its existing foreign exchange standard FRS 121, which will result in exchange differences arising from investment in foreign operations to be recognised in equity. Previously, exchange differences arising from such transactions between companies in a group would be accounted for in income statement or equity depending on the currency of the monetary item. But with the amendment, such transactions and their foreign currency differences will be treated as part of reporting entity net investment and recognised in equity.

MASB also issued 6 new Interpretations to a number of existing standards covering a wide range of industry, from mining to financial services, as follows:

■ IC Interpretation 1 Changes in Existing Decommissioning, Restoration & Similar Liabilities

- IC Interpretation 2 Members' Shares in Co-operative Entities & Similar Instruments
- IC Interpretation 5 Rights to Interests arising from Decommissioning, Restoration and Environmental Rehabilitation Funds
- IC Interpretation 6 Liabilities arising from participating in a specific market Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment
- IC Interpretation 7 Applying the Restatement Approach under FRS 129₂₀₀₄
- IC Interpretation 8 Scope of FRS 2

The interpretation is a form of guidance issued to deal with conflicting views on issues not specifically addressed in the accounting standards, which will help to minimise divergent accounting practices. For further information, please visit www.masb.com.my

Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM)

Anti-Money Laundering Act 2001

Bank Negara Malaysia has issued the Standard Guidelines and Sectoral Guidelines 6 for Designated Non-Financial Business and Professions relating to Anti Money Laundering and Counter Financing of Terrorism pursuant to its power to issue guidelines under Section 83 of the Anti Money Laundering Act 2001. The guidelines will be effective from February 2, 2007.

The Sectoral Guidelines 6 is applicable to MIA members who hold valid practising certificates issued pursuant to rule 9 of the Malaysian Institute of Accountants (Membership and Council) *Rules 2001 [P.U. (A) 343/2001*, which are reporting institutions under the Anti-Money Laundering Act 2001 (AMLA).

Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM)

SSM Annual Dialogue Session

The SSM Annual Dialogue Session will be held on March 15, 2007. Securities Commission (SC)

February 9, 2007

The Securities Commission (SC) continued to perform strongly in delivering on its time charter for processing of licensing and corporate applications. During the fourth quarter 2006, 99 per cent of licensing applications and 84 per cent of corporate proposals were processed within the stipulated time. This high level of delivery was achieved despite a significant increase in licensing applications. During the October - December period the SC received 503 applications, an 81 per cent increase, compared with 278 applications received in the previous quarter.
