MINISTRY OF FINANCE (MOF)

Goods and Services Tax

Further to Circular No. TEC/004/01/2010 (W) dated January 14, 2010, members' are informed that the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Bill was tabled in Dewan Rakyat on December 16, 2009 by Minister of Finance II, YB Dato' Hj Ahmad Husni bin Mohamad Hanadzlah.

The main purpose for the introduction of GST is to make the current taxation system more comprehensive, efficient, transparent and business friendly. The Government is proposing to impose GST of 4% and would be implemented in the middle of the year 2011.

The Institute is in the process of preparing a memorandum on the proposed GST for submission to the Ministry of Finance. In this regard, members were invited to submit any views or suggestions on the proposed GST, and where deemed appropriate by the Institute, would be submitted to the Ministry of Finance for their consideration.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Programmes

Real Property Gains Tax – Implications & Exemptions

The MICPA is organising a one-day Workshop on *Real Property Gains Tax (RPGT) – Implications & Exemptions* on March 11, 2010 at Best Western Premier Seri Pacific Kuala Lumpur. RPGT is a tax levied by the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) on chargeable gains derived from the disposal of real property and disposal shares in a real property company.

The workshop will be led by Mr Chow Chee Yen who will also discuss the practical issues that may be encountered on RPGT transactions and some practical tax planning ideas. IFRS 9 and Updates on Accounting for Financial Instruments

The MICPA is organising a one-day Seminar on *IFRS 9 and Updates on Accounting for Financial Instruments* on March 29, 2010 at Best Western Premier Seri Pacific Hotel Kuala Lumpur.

The objective of the Seminar is to update participants on the simplified approach to the classification and measurement of financial assets. With the clarification on this simplified approach, you would be able to make an assessment of whether or not to go for early adoption of IFRS 9 when FRS 9 is issued in Malaysia. The Seminar also provides a review of the related updates on accounting for financial instruments.

The Seminar Leaders will explain the standards prescribed in the new IFRS 9 and other new amendments, illustrate with examples on their application and compare them with the current standards in FRS 139. Participants will be guided for assessing whether early adoption is feasible.

News from IFAC and IASB

INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF ACCOUNTANTS (IFAC)

IFAC Releases Revised Global Leadership Survey

International standards are crucial to investor and financial stability, according to IFAC's recently released revised Global Leadership Survey. Survey participants, which included over 110 presidents and chief executives of IFAC's member bodies, and regional organisations and groupings, believe that investors and all consumers of financial information deserve clear, reliable, and consistent information.

Their responses emphasized that IFAC needs to continue to lead the convergence of standards developed by its independent standard-setting boards, relating to auditing and assurance, education, ethics and public sector accounting, and to support the implementation of those standards. In addition, respondents showed strong support for IFAC's recommendation to the G-20 that regulation or re-regulation in financial policies should not place unreasonable burdens on SMEs.

Looking to the future, the survey identified the following as top priorities by leaders of the accountancy profession: Increase confidence in international standards for accounting and auditing, in both the private sector and the public sector; and adopt but also implement international standards, including principles of good corporate governance. In addition, respondents expect demand for professional accountants, as well as student interest in the accountancy profession, to remain high or increase in the next three years, according to the survey results.

IPSASB Issues Exposure Draft on Service Concession Arrangements by Grantors

The International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB) is seeking comments on an exposure draft (ED) entitled *Service Concession Arrangements: Grantor* that presents requirements and guidance on how grantors recognize, account for, and disclose assets in service concession arrangements.

This is the first proposed standard to address the accounting for such arrangements from the grantor's perspective as IFRIC 12, Service Concession Arrangements, issued by the International Financial Reporting Interpretations Committee (IFRIC), applies only to the operators of these arrangements.

IPSASB Publishes Intangible Assets Standard and Improvements Document

The IPSASB has published a new International Public Sector Accounting Standard—IPSAS 31, *Intangible Assets*—that covers the accounting for and disclosure of intangible assets. Primarily drawn from the International Accounting Standards Board's (IASB) International Accounting Standard (IAS) 38, *Intangible Assets*, the standard does not deal with uniquely public sector issues, such as powers and rights conferred by legislation, a constitution, or by equivalent means, but it does include guidance on intangible heritage assets. It also contains extracts from the IASB's Standing Interpretations Committee Interpretation 32, *Intangible Assets—Web Site Costs*, and adds application guidance and illustrations that have not yet been incorporated into the IAS.

Improvements to IPSASs, another recently published IPSASB document, sets out amendments to IPSASs and the related Bases for Conclusions, comparisons with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS)/IASs, and guidance to conform with minor changes to IFRSs that were made since the related IPSASs were originally released. INTERNATIONAL ACCOUNTING STANDARDS BOARD (IASB)

IASC Foundation Publishes Proposed IFRS Taxonomy 2010

The International Accounting Standards Committee (IASC) Foundation has published for public comment an exposure draft of the *International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) Taxonomy 2010.* The proposed taxonomy is consistent with IFRSs and the IFRS for Small and Medium-sized Entities (SMEs).

The proposed taxonomy contains significant architectural improvements when compared with the 2009 version; in particular the proposed architecture integrates IFRSs and the IFRS for SMEs into a single taxonomy. Other proposed improvements include an extended use of axes (dimensions) in the taxonomy, reconsideration of the IASC Foundation's approach for concept naming and of its principle of deleting redundant (deprecated) concepts.

The IFRS Taxonomy 2010 is a translation of IFRSs as issued at January 1, 2010 into XBRL (eXtensible Business Reporting Language). XBRL is rapidly becoming the format of choice for the electronic filing of financial information - particularly within jurisdictions reporting under IFRSs - because it facilitates simpler and faster filing and comparison of IFRS financial data by companies, regulators, investors, analysts and other users of the IFRS Taxonomy.

Interested parties are invited to comment on the exposure draft of the IFRS Taxonomy 2010 and accompanying materials by April 22, 2010. The proposed taxonomy and related material can be accessed here. The final version is expected to be released at the end of April 2010.

Working Draft of Proposed IFRS to Replace IAS 37 is now available

The IASB has posted on its website a working draft of a proposed IFRS to replace IAS 37 *Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets*. The working draft is based on proposals published for comment in 2005, amended for decisions the IASB has taken in the light of comments it received.

The working draft includes revised measurement proposals that the IASB published separately for comment on January 5, 2010. The IASB announced then that it would post a working draft of the entire IFRS on its website this month to enable interested parties to see the revised measurement proposals in the context of the IFRS as a whole.
