The remaining three modules will also be sponsored by the approved accounting firm or ATO once the student has graduated from university. The sponsorship will cover module and student registration fees.

In return, the students will be required to work for the Approved Training Employers during their six-month structured internship as well as upon completion of their Bachelor of Accountancy degree programme for a period of not less than three years.

The internship allows students to work in an environment that is very invigorating and facilitates learning and development and the practical application of skills in a dynamic setting to hone their accounting skills in real, life situations and build contacts with business leaders:
