MAPPING OF GST TAX CODES AND INPUT TAX

Mapping of GST tax codes is new to most of the accounting personnel in Malaysia. The tax codes recommended is to allow proper classifications of typical purchase and supply scenarios by GST-registered businesses for the purpose of GST. Understanding the 23 recommended tax codes and ensuring that tax codes are set up correctly at the initial stage is crucial for GST return submission. Understanding the difference between claimable and blocked import tax is also crucial for business to avoid submitting an incorrect GST return.

The objective of this Workshop is to help participants to understand transitional issues, pertinent GST matters such as claiming input tax credits and identifying blocked input tax. The Workshop also covers the time of supply rules for GST reporting, the GST mapping process in the GST implementation era and the practical considerations and potential challenges to be faced by businesses during GST mapping and implementation stage.
