

Honouring excellent students

THE Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA) held its annual presentation of Excellence Awards, Examination Certificates and Prizes, Membership and Practising Certificates at a special ceremony recently.

The Excellence Awards represents an important part of the Institute's efforts to promote accountancy and to accord honour and public recognition to young Malaysians who have achieved all-round excellence in the pursuit of an accounting qualification as well as in extra-curricular activities and personal development.

Two categories of awards were presented, The Excellence Award for the Most Outstanding CPA Student and the Excellence Awards for Best Accounting Graduates.

The Excellence Award for the Most Outstanding CPA Student award is bestowed on the best all-round CPA student who has recently completed the MICPA professional examinations.

The Excellence Awards for Best Accounting Graduates award is presented to the top accounting graduate from each of the local universities that offer the Bachelor of Accountancy qualification.
