ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID



ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Born in Geylang near the famous Kampong Geylang Serai, Singapore



ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Educated in Anglo-Chinese School, Singapore



ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- After completing his Higher School Certificate, he joined Cooper Brothers & Co (now PwC) in 1964 as an Audit Trainee rather than pursuing a Science course at the University of Singapore
- He was the first HSC holder to join the Firm when the general intake was for School Certificate Grade 1 holders

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Seconded to the Sydney office, Australia to pursue the ICAA examinations from 1966 - 1974
- Returned to KL after qualifying & joined Bank Pertanian Malaysia (now Agrobank) on a work permit as Internal Audit Manager from 1975 - 1976
- Became a Malaysian citizen under Article 19(2) in 1977

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Joined Peat Marwick Desa Megat (now KPMG) in 1977 and admitted as a Partner in 1979
- Elected Deputy Senior Partner in 1990 and in 1995 elected as Senior Partner in which capacity, he served until his retirement in 2000.
- Appointed as Adjunct Professor by International Islamic University of Malaysia in 1985 & lectured final year students in Auditing

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- In 2001, appointed by the Minister of Finance as Executive Chairman of The Kuala Lumpur Options and Financial Futures Exchange (KLOFFE) for 2 years.



ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Involved in the merger of the Kuala Lumpur Commodities Exchange (KLCE) and the Malaysian Monetary Exchange (MME) to form the Commodity and Monetary Exchange of Malaysia (COMMEX)
- Thereafter involved in the merger of COMMEX and KLOFFE resulting in the formation of the Malaysia Derivatives Exchange (MDEX), which then became a subsidiary of the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange (KLSE).

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- He has served on the Boards of the following public listed companies, as well as as Chairman of the Audit Committee as well as a member of the Nomination & Remuneration Committees:

 - Proton Holdings Bhd

 - Tradewinds Corporation Bhd
 - Golden Pharos Bhd

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

He is currently a Board member of:

- Bank Muamalat Malaysia Bhd where he is the Chairman of Board Audit and member of the Board Risk Management, Remuneration and Nomination
- Opcom Holdings Bhd where he is Chairman of the Nominating & Remuneration Committee

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

- Admitted as a Member of MICPA in 1975 (Membership No. 802)
- Elected to MICPA Council in 1981 and served till 2010
- Appointed to the Executive Committee from 1988 - 2010
- Served as President of MICPA from 1996 - 1998
- Chairman of the Education & Training Committee from 1987 - 1996
- Chairman of the Examination Committee from 1999 until his retirement as Council Member

ABDUL JABBAR BIN ABDUL MAJID

During his time on the Council, he has served as:

- Member of the Membership Affairs Committee, Code of Ethics Committee, Technical Committee, Strategic Planning Committee, Bahasa Malaysia Committee, Conference Organising Committee, Financial Statements Review Committee, Government Affairs Committee, Admin & Financial Affairs Committee
- Member of the Disciplinary Committee from 1981 – 1993, 2003-2006, & continued on the Committee as Alternate Chairman from 2007 – 2009

- Member of the Insolvency Practice Committee from 1994 – 1995, and 1999 – 2002
- Member of the Investigation Committee in 1998 and then served as Alternate Chairman in 1999
- Upon his retirement from Council, he still serves as a trustee of the MACPA Educational Trust Fund since 2011.

- He is a Committee member of Persatuan Al-Hunafa, a non-profit organisation dedicated to Islamic education & welfare
- Involved in teaching and helping the underprivileged to be self-supporting and independent
