Developing Future Accountants

An annual event especially for accounting students, the MICPA-CAANZ Accountancy Week 2016 was organised by The Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA) and Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (CAANZ) to promote the accounting profession and develop a community of students who excel not just academically, but as all-rounders. The event garnered keen interest from participants in the MICPA-CAANZ Programme — a professional accounting programme offered jointly by MICPA and CAANZ, as it is the only Programme available in Malaysia that provides its graduates with two qualifications upon the completion of one set of examinations, and the use of two professional designations — Certified Public Accountant (Malaysia) and Chartered Accountant (Australia and New Zealand).
