Question 1: When will the Main exams be held?

Module	Date of Exam
TAX120	6 May 2020 (Wednesday)
AAA120	12 May 2020 (Tuesday)
CAP120	2 June 2020 (Tuesday)

Question 2: When will the Supplementary exams be held?

Module	Date of Exam
TAX120	23 June 2020 (Tuesday)
AAA120	24 June 2020 (Wednesday)
CAP120	14 July 2020 (Tuesday)

Question 3: What are the modes of the Main and Supplementary exams?

Module	Mode of Exam
TAX120	Face-to face seated exams (venue determined by MICPA)
AAA120	Online examination (at home or a comfortable place to attend the examination without any disturbance)
CAP120	Online examination (at home or a comfortable place to attend the examination without any disturbance)

Question 4: Do I have to sit for the online / face-to face examination?

No, if you do not wish to sit for the exam, options will be given to you.
(Refer Question 5 for more details)

Question 5: What are the options given?

Option 1	Continue with Term 1 module enrolment and complete exams face-to-face / online (refer to Question 1 for the Main exam dates)
Option 2	Defer Term 1 module exam to the next Main exam of the module (currently scheduled in Term 2 for Capstone and Term 3 for AAA / TAX) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No financial implication• Results will be recorded as pending until you complete your exam in Term 2/3• Project paper / online assessment marks will be carried forward to Term 2/3
Option 3	Defer Term 1 module exam to the Supplementary exam sitting <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you choose this option, there will not be an opportunity for you to sit for an additional supplementary exam• Therefore, if you fail the Term 1 Supplementary exam, you will need to undertake this module in the future offering.• Project paper / online assessment marks will be carried forward to the Supplementary exam.
Option 4	Fully withdraw from Term 1 module enrolment and receive a full refund <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No late charges will be imposed• Undertake all the assessments in the future module enrolment

Question 6: How do I select my option?

For AAA120 / CAP120: If you would like to choose Option 2-4, please go to the myLearning portal and make your selection following the “**COVID-19 Term120 Module Continuation Options Survey**” tab sitting under the “Announcements” tab.

(Note: Those who plan to continue with Term 1 module enrolled, you do not need to complete the survey)

For TAX120: Please email your option to exam@micpa.com.my

In your email clearly state:

- a) Your Name
- b) Student ID
- c) Module
- d) Your preferred option

(Note: Those who plan to continue with Term 1 module enrolment and exam sitting also have to email to us)

Question 7: When is the deadline to defer / withdraw?

AAA120 and TAX120 – deadline is 14 April 2020 (Tuesday)

CAP120 – deadline is 8 May 2020 (Friday)

Question 8: What should I do if I have completed the survey but now wish to change my mind on the option.

You can retake the survey.

Question 9: What happens to the options given prior to this FAQ?

Null & void.

Question 10: Will MICPA proceed with the TAX120 exam dated 21 April 2020?

No. The exam has been postponed to 6 May 2020. (refer to Question 1).

Question 11: Do the Supplementary exam dates remain as per the timetable?

No. Please refer to Question 2 for the Supplementary exam dates.

Question 12: Will the Supplementary exam be conducted online as well?

Yes, the Supplementary exam for AAA / CAP will be conducted online. For the TAX exam, you will need to be physically present at the predetermined exam venue.

Question 13: Will Workshop 2 and Workshop 3 for CAP120 be conducted online?

Yes, from now onwards the workshops will be conducted online until further notice.

Question 14: Can I defer CAP120 to Term 2?

You can defer provided that you complete all the 3 workshops and defer the main exam only.
