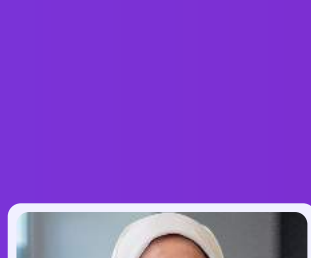


#### Evelyn Chee
