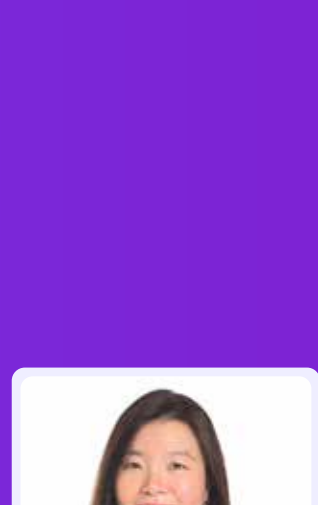
SPEAKER'S PROFILE

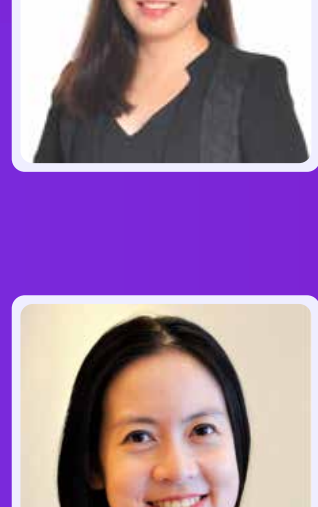

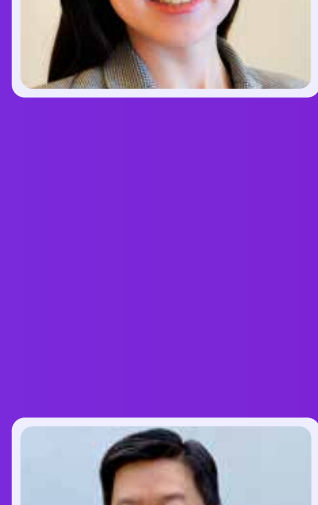
Adjunct Practice Prof. Cheah Kok Hoong

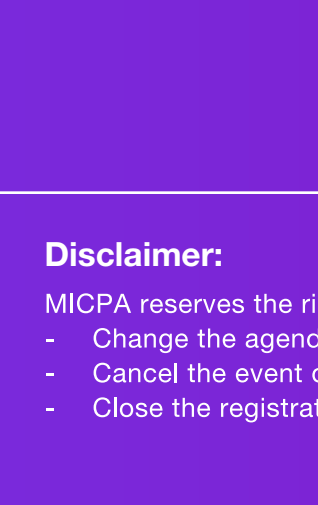

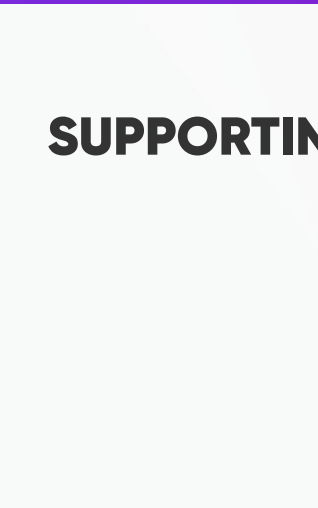
Nusaybah Mohamad Sofian

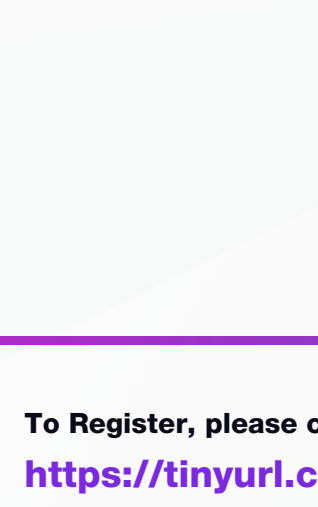
